

## The ASU Masters Program Announces Reality-based Enhanced & Applied Learning (REAL) Grant

## STUDENT FELLOWSHIP

**ASU Masters Degree Reality-based Enhanced & Applied Learning Grant (REAL)** began in the FALL of 2017. This grant includes a student traineeship that is funded by the Federal Department of Education. It is available to African American or economically disadvantaged (low income) students who are currently enrolled in the Graduate Program in Math Education, Nursing, and Science Education.

The major student support objectives of the grant are to:

- 1. Improve academic success: through provision of mentors and tutorial services as indicated to promote retention
- 2. Successful student recruitment and progression, of well qualified candidates and supply a more diverse group of math educators, nurses, and science educators to the workforce, and retain students ambitions for those pursing a graduate degree in the areas of mathematics education, nursing, and science education.

The intentions of the fellowship are to provide financial assistance to students with educationally or economically disadvantaged backgrounds who are in <u>pursuit of full-time</u> math education, nursing, and science education studies. Students must be in **good academic standing with a GPA of 3.00**. Students should also indicate a plan such that the fellowship will increase the student's ability to take more classes. Students who meet these criteria will be eligible for Math, Nursing, and Science Education Fellowships.

In consideration of the rigorous nature of the graduate program and availability of classes, fulltime pursuit of graduate studies in nursing, science education and math education may, or may not, comprise a full-time credit hour load during the Summer semester. Each program participant must be a U.S. citizen, (non-citizen national, or foreign national who possesses a visa permitting permanent residence in the United States.)

All fellowships are awarded to support academic excellence, and relieve financial need so that students can progress through the graduate program **in a timely manner**. The Fellowships Committee reviews all applications and selects the fellowship awardees. Awardees will be notified of their selection by ASU email or via US mail. *This award may affect your financial aid*.



- Must be Enrolled in the Albany State University Graduate Program
  - Math Education, Nursing, or Science Education
- Must be a full-time student at Albany State University
  - o Completing their Program of Study in a timely manner (2 years).
  - o Submit a Program Assessment Form each semester
  - o Schedule appointment with the Academic Success Coach
    - New Applicants [within 1<sup>st</sup> month]
    - As needed (open)
    - Exiting Applicants
- No funding support for TAP recipients
- Nursing Programs
  - o Uninterrupted semester schedules ex: Research to Thesis Defense
  - Grant support for Thesis/Scholarly Project <u>2 semesters only</u>
- Maintain a GPA of 3.0.
- Regularly attend tutorial sessions as needed online and on ASU campus.
- Attend and participate in all required ASUREAL program meetings.
- Must demonstrate professional behavior while interacting with other students, staff, faculty, and administrators.
- Attend scientific meetings and present their research with the assistance of their faculty mentors at one or more local, regional, or national conferences; including the Graduate Research Symposium's.
- Must have a curriculum vitae and "Statement of Goals" in the Grant Coordinator's office.
- Updated application each Fall, along with an updated "statement of goals"

Should a student be awarded funds for any specific semester and then drop or withdraw from classes, that student's funding for those classes will be rescinded.
