

Pertinent Pointers: Please Read

Enrolling into a college course is a big decision. While becoming a dual enrollment student has many benefits, students will need to make sure they understand what being a dual enrollment student means. Please take into account the following:

- You are considered a college student to Professors, not a high school student. This means you will be treated as a college student, and all rules, regulations, and policies of Albany State University will apply to you.
- Make sure you read your class **SYLLABUS**. This will be your guide to what requirements your Professor has as far as attendance, grading policy, late work, etc.
- MOWR students must maintain ASU SAP Policy. You received one in your new student packet.
- Attendance is very important in college. Missing a few classes or being tardy can cause your grade to be lowered. Read the syllabus to find out your Professors policy.

- The grades you make in college classes could affect your HOPE Scholarship GPA.
- While tuition, books, and most fees are at no cost to the student there is still some cost that may fall on the student. Course related fees such as lab fees and tuition for non-approved classes are the responsibility of the student.
- In order for your parents to have access to your Records you must have a (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) form signed and turned in to our Records Department.
- Any holds must be taken care of before you can register for the next semester, or have your transcript sent to any school.
- If you need help please do not be afraid to ask for it.
- Log in to D2L, whether you are taking an on campus or online class. You may be asked to do so in both types of classes. If you need help logging on please ask your Professor, an Online Support Specialist, or the MOWR Coordinator.
- Make sure to check your official ASU email for regular updates. This is how the MOWR Coordinator will communicate with you. If you have questions about your username and password please let the MOWR Coordinator know or contact the IT Helpdesk.
