

The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant is awarded by Albany State University to students who are completing, or intend to complete, coursework to begin a career in teaching and who agree to serve for a minimum of four years as a full-time, highly-qualified, high-need field teacher in a low-income school.

If students awarded the TEACH Grant do not complete the four years of qualified teaching service within eight years of completing their Degree Program for which the TEACH Grant was received, or otherwise fail to meet any other requirements of the TEACH Grant, the Grant will convert into a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan, with interest accrued and capitalized from the date of original disbursement.

The U.S. Department of Education provides the funding for this program. Eligible full-time students may receive \$3708 per aid year in TEACH Grant funds, up to a maximum of \$16,000 for undergraduate and \$8,000 for graduate study. Post-baccalaureate teacher certification students enrolled at Albany State University do not qualify for this program.

### To qualify for a TEACH Grant, Albany State University students must:

- 1. Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov for the academic year the student wishes to receive the TEACH Grant. (*Please note that TEACH Grant is not based on financial need*).
- 2. Meet certain academic achievement requirements:

#### *Incoming transfers*

- Have a transferable cumulative college grade point average (GPA) of 3.25 or higher and
- Must have Junior Level Classification and
- Be admitted into the College of Education

#### Current ASU undergraduates

- Have a cumulative college grade point average (GPA) of 3.25 or higher and
- Must have Junior Level Classification and
- Be admitted into the College of Education

#### Incoming Master's level students

- Have an undergraduate cumulative college grade point average (GPA) of 3.25 or higher or
- Have scored above the 75th percentile on at least one battery of a nationally recognized admission test (Such as GRE)

#### Current ASU Master's level students

- Have a cumulative college grade point average (GPA) of 3.25 or higher or
- Have scored above the 75th percentile on at least one battery of a nationally recognized admission test (Such as GRE)
- 3. Enroll in coursework necessary to complete a teach certification in a high-need field.
