Preparatory Coursework refers to coursework that is part of an eligible program offered by the school, although the student has not yet been admitted into the program because prerequisite courses must be taken to qualify for admission into the program. If enrolled at least half time in these prerequisite courses, the student is eligible for loans for one consecutive 12-month period (not per program) beginning on the first day of the loan period. The annual loan amount for preparatory coursework is set by the Department of Education and varies from other loan amounts. Students enrolled in preparatory coursework are not eligible for federal grants.

<u>Please note:</u> To be eligible for loans under this exception, the student must be taking classes that are a prerequisite for admission into an ASU program. A student who is only taking courses to raise his or her GPA in order to be admitted would not qualify.
