Storage/Cleaning Supplies

- Storage Bins/Organizers
- Trash Can/Trash Bags

- Dustpan/Floor Cleaner (Swifter)
- Clorox based Shower Spray & Toilet Cleaner
- Liquid and Pods Laundry Detergent only
- Plunger & Toilet Brush

- Bed Risers
- Fitness/Dancing Poles
- Electric Scooters
- Skate Boards

Appliances

- BBQ Grills
- Deep Fryer
- Air Fryer
- Toaster Oven
- Coffee Maker (Keurig only)
- Electric Space Heater
- Crockpot
- Pressure Cookers

- Anything with a hot surface: pressure cookers, instapots, broilers, toaster ovens, electric skillet, hot plates,


